# HAPPY CAMPERS

Barbuda Ocean Club's Community Office provided resources and funding to three outstanding summer camps for Barbudan youth:

## BECOMING

A three-week girls' camp, focusing on personal development through art, dance and theater. Supported in cooperation with the Coco Point Fund. BECOMING attracted 25 campers who explored concepts such as: self-identity, goal setting, self-worth, health boundaries, self-esteem, self-care and life experiences. ## YOUTH EMPOWERMENT CAMP

Also in conjunction with Coco Point Fund, this camp taught a diverse curriculum of subjects including climate change, photography and technology, crafts, and cooking.

## BLUE OCEAN HALO CAMP

This weeklong camp engaged in lectures and experiential activities involving the ocean. Campers learned invaluable lessons about coral reefs, marine protected areas and the parrotfish. Members of the Outdoor Pursuits Team at Barbuda Ocean Club provided a session focused on ecologically friendly sports activities including kayaking and standup paddle boarding.
